

# What you should know about the...

## Sponge Boy Jumping Room

### Before your event:

- ★ If you setup the jumper yourself, make sure you follow instructions for proper use. Set jumper on a level and flat surface that is clear of any debris and overhead obstructions like wires and trees.
- ★ Make sure the jumper is fully inflated before you let riders in. A partially inflated jumper can result in injuries.
- ★ Make sure that all the tie-downs and the blower are securely fastened.

### During your event:

- ★ All riders must remove their shoes, jewelry, watches, rings and eyeglasses. They must also remove any hard or sharp objects from their pockets that could injure themselves or another ride while jumping.
- ★ ABSOLUTELY NO SILLY STRING IN OR AROUND THE JUMPER AT ANY TIME. THIS WILL RUIN THE INFLATABLE AND YOU WILL BE RESPONSIBLE.
- ★ Riders should all be of the same age group and should be limited to the maximum number of riders shown below. Never allow more riders in the unit than as shown. There must be a competent adult at all times supervising the riders.

	Under 5 yrs.	6-8 yr olds	9-13 yr olds	Older teens

### Weather-related information:

- ★ In the event of severe weather, remove all riders from the jumper and unplug immediately. Make sure the jumper remains securely anchored. Do not inflate until severe weather stops. As conditions permit, inflate jumper and allow it to dry before using it again. Never allow playing on a wet jumper.
- ★ When tearing down the jumper, never roll it up while it is still wet or damp. Use a towel to dry it off if necessary. Rolling the inflatable up while it's still damp will result in mold and damage to the inflatable.

### General Rules:

- ★ No flips, rough play, wrestling or climbing on the nets or outside.
- ★ No food, drinks, gum or painted faces with make-up that will stick to jumper.
- ★ NO SILLY STRING
- ★ Do not put water on jumper

If jumper becomes unplugged or loses power during operation, the supervisor should hold open the door and allow the riders to exit. There is no cause for alarm.
